Abstract

The EU has undergone substantial legislative change driven by the green agenda. While industry supports the overall objective behind those policies, legislative requirements have come in quick succession by the EU legislators. These will have notable cumulation and increased interconnectivity with the pharma agenda. This interlinkage makes it confusing for innovators and regulators to navigate the landscape with the multiple interplays and moving targets. Moreover, the implementation is set to cooccur, creating uncertainty and tight timelines. This poses a significant challenge for the already highly regulated pharmaceutical sector, potentially leading to unintended negative consequences on the availability of medicines to patients and the sustainability and competitiveness of Europe's pharmaceutical and healthcare sector. The presentation will give an overview of these identified impacts and discuss recommendations to be taken further by industry and EU decision-makers.

Kirsty Reid is the Director for Science Policy at EFPIA, She holds a PhD in Biology. She is a team leader and Science Policy topic lead, and her focus includes innovation policy implementation with a particular emphasis on science and research matters. She has 20 years of experience in EU public and regulatory affairs covering various EU legislation and policy areas, working specifically on animal experimentation, alternatives to animal testing, and environment, health and safety issues. In EFPIA she leads the work on the environmental and chemical dossiers impacting the pharmaceutical sector.
